The PICYA has been holding Opening Day On The Bay on the last Sunday of April for 103 years.

We cannot meet in Honolulu for the RI Convention or our Post Convention Cruise (PCC) but we can connect with each other by decorating our boats or creating decorated model boats and then sharing them with each other via photographs to keep the IYFR spirit and our shared love of boating alive this year! All entries of decorated boats or model boats will be shared in a PowerPoint with IYFR and Rotarians around the world! No boat is too big or too small and no decorations are too elaborate or too modest to enter.

HERE ARE THE "RULES":

- 1. Any IYFR fleet or individual IYFR member may enter, along with non-IYFR Rotarians, Rotaractors, and Interactors. Children and grandchildren may help.
- 2. Decorated boats may be model boats or real boats of any type or size.
- 3. Decorate or create boats to express the 2019-2020 Rotary International theme *Rotary Connects The World*.
- 4. Use your imagination and show national or regional pride or type of boat.
- 5. Send up to **3 photographs** of your boat.
- 6. FORMAT FOR ENTRIES: please provide
 - **a. WORD Document** with description of entry.
 - **b. JPEG** format in high resolution of photograph(s) of each boat.




