POST CONVENTION CRUISE 24th – 27th JUNE 2010

Cruise the 1000 Islands of the St. Lawrence Seaway, Ontario, on board the replica Steamboat “Canadian Empress”

Departing Montreal on the morning of 24th June, and travelling by coach to historic Kingston – Canada’s first Capitol – stopping for lunch, and a tour of Fort Henry. *Originally built during the War between Great Britain (Canada being a British Colony at the time) and the United States of America. Rebuilt in 1832, and restored in 1936, the Fort opened as a Museum in 1938.*

We board the Canadian Empress at approximately 5.30pm.

The cost of the cruise includes all meals, on board entertainment, tours and attractions.

- 24th June: Board the Canadian Empress at 5.30pm. Welcome dinner – meet old friends and make new acquaintances.
- 25th June: Dinner with an “a la French” theme.
- 26th June: International Night. Each country represented on the cruise presents an item.
- 27th June: After lunch we disembark at 2.30pm

Members may wish to travel on to Toronto, back to Montreal or even stay on a few days in Kingston. Rotary Convention Attendees qualify for 10% discount on Canadian Rail, or depending on the interest, a coach may be able to be organized, to go to Toronto. 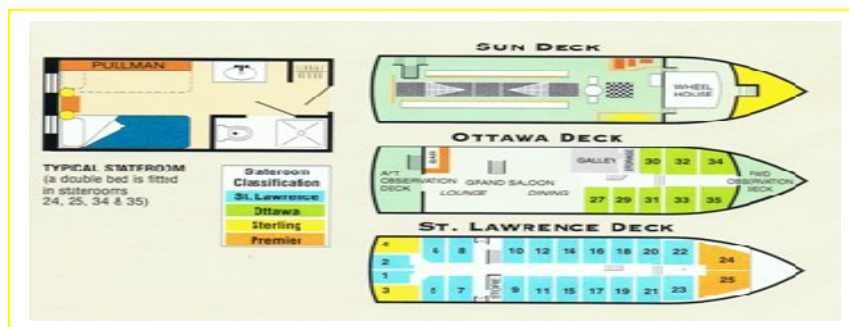
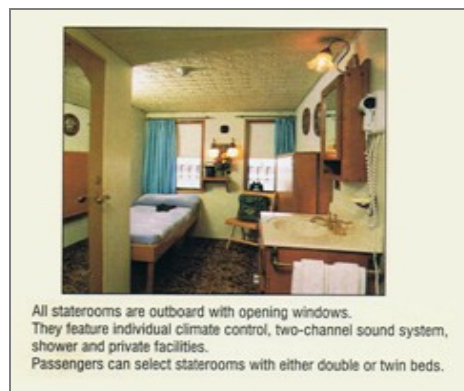
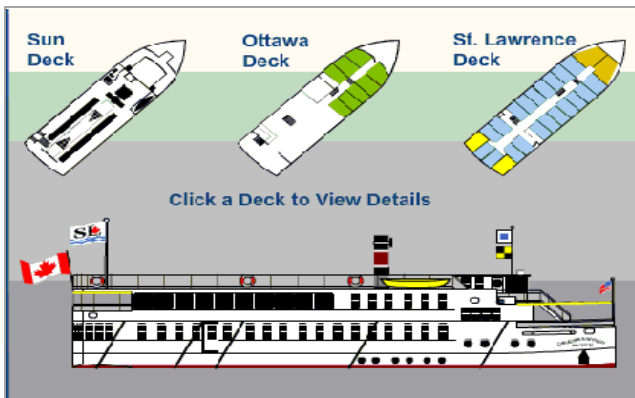
